Motion to approve creation of an Ad Hoc Committee on General Education Review and Revision – Jan Lewis (Associate Provost), General Education Council, and Keith Cooper (Philosophy), Educational Policies Committee. **ACTION ITEM.**

Resolved, that the faculty create an Ad Hoc Committee on General Education Review and Revision, as presented in Attachment E.

PROPOSAL: To create an Ad Hoc Committee on General Education Review and Revision

OBJECTIVES: (1) To review our existing General Education program to determine whether our students and our educational mission might be better served by a revised model. (2) If a revision seems warranted, to create at least two proposed models to bring to Faculty Assembly for discussion in May 2018. (3) To bring a revised curriculum to the assembly for vote sometime in Fall 2018.

MEMBERSHIP:

Appointed by the provost in consultation with Provost's Academic Council

At least one faculty member from each school and division

No more than one person from any department or school

- Co-chairs: Chair of the Faculty and one CAS dean (2)
- Faculty from this year's General Education Council (4)
- Faculty from this year's Educational Policies Committee (2-3)
- ~~At large faculty, to ensure broad representation (1-4)~~
- At large faculty elected from a slate prepared by the Governance Committee, to ensure broad representation (2)
- Students selected by ASPLU (2)
- Advisory member: Jan Lewis, Associate Provost for Undergraduate Programs
- **Dean of Inclusive Excellence**

TIMELINE:

October 2017: Proposal brought to Faculty Assembly (brought by EPC and Gen Ed Council)

Fall 2017: Committee meets to create calendar for spring work

February 2018: Committee begins its work

May 2018: Committee brings models to Faculty Assembly for informal discussion

Fall 2018: Committee brings models (or updated models) to Faculty Assembly for continued discussion, with any votes on a revised curriculum taking place by December 2018
