## Program Cost Sheet 2025 Master of Arts in Education Alternative Route to Secondary Certification



The MAE Alternative Routes with Secondary Certification requires 34 semester credits for completion. Students can choose to complete both the certification and the degree requirements, or complete the certification portion only.

- The certification portion is 24 semester hours from summer 2025 to spring 2026.
- After completion of the certificate portion, students have 3 years (by spring 2028) to complete the remaining 10 credits required for the MAE degree.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Total program tuition for certification (24 credits): \$23,304 (\$971 per credit)

Total program tuition for certification plus MAE (34 credits): \$33,014 (\$971 per credit)

English Language Learners and Special Education endorsement options represent an additional tuition cost.

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$270/year), wellness fee (\$110/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$205), books and materials for coursework, certification, fingerprinting, etc. (Subject to change)
